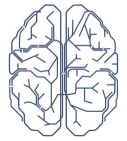

Volunteers needed for Research Study on Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (ME/CFS)

The UCLA Neuromodulation Division at the UCLA Semel Institute is currently seeking participants for a study to analyze how brain stimulation affects symptoms of a condition called Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (ME/CFS).

Qualifications:

- Female or identify as female
- Are between the ages of 18 and 75
- Diagnosis of Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/Chronic Fatigue Syndrome

Participation involves:

- Brain stimulation treatments once daily (Mon-Fri) for 30 visits
- Completion of up three (3) brain activity recordings
- Completion of weekly assessments about physical and mental well-being

Potential Benefits: Participants in this study may experience improvement in fatigue, pain and/or cognitive symptoms.
